## Tax Collections

### PAYMENT OF TAXES: First

installments are due on or before **January 31, 2010**. Checks should be made payable to: Village of Dane. For your convenience, payments can be placed into the drop box at the Village office front door. Payments can also be mailed to Village of Dane, PO Box 168, Dane, WI 53529. If a receipt is required, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Payments will be accepted at the Village office. The office will be closed on the following days:

The office will be open on Wednesday December 30th from 8 am–11 am, 1 pm–4 pm, and 6 pm to 8 pm accepting payments. The office will also be open on Sunday December 27th from 1 pm–4 pm.

Please note that payments received in the drop box over the New Years weekend will be considered as received by December 31st, 2009.

## Dog Licenses

If you have licensed a dog in the past, an application is included with your tax bill. All dog licenses must be renewed annually [Ordinance Sec. 7-1-1] by **March 31st**.

**Fees:** Neutered/spayed \$10.00; unneutered/unspayed \$15.00. Send the dog license application(s), a copy of the vaccination certificate(s), and payment along with a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Village of Dane.

A \$20.00 late fee is assessed for licenses obtained after April 1. If you include the application with your tax payment, please write a separate check for the dog license. Additional applications can be obtained in the village office.





## Seasonal Parking and Snow Removal

**SEASONAL PARKING:** Effective November 15- March 15, no vehicle shall be parked or left standing on the streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Violators could be subject to parking fines and/or towing.

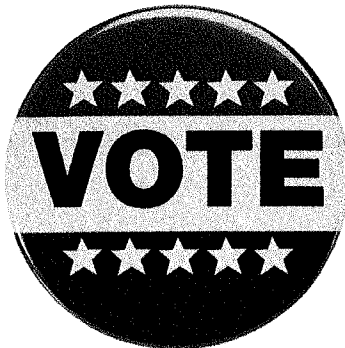
**SNOW REMOVAL:** Snow must be removed from the sidewalks within 24 hours of a snowfall. No snow is to be plowed, shoveled or blown into the street. Violators can be subject to fines.

**REMINDER:** Village Ordinance 10-1-20 prohibits the parking of cars, trucks, trailers and campers in the same location for more than 48 consecutive hours March 16-November 14. Violators may be subject to having their vehicle impounded.

**FIRE HYDRANTS:** For your protection, the Dane Fire Department asks that you keep fire hydrants clear of snow and ice.



## Voter Registration and Election Dates



**VOTER REGISTRATION:** Since January 2006 all voters will need to complete a voter registration form. If you haven't already, stop in the Village office and register. You will need your driver's license or Wisconsin ID number. If you do not have a Wisconsin Driver's license, you can use your Social Security number.

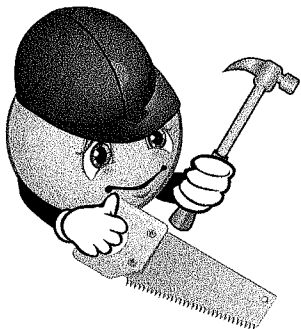

## Building Inspector



Due to the economic down turn the Building Inspector does not have hours in the Village. Applications can be picked up at Village Hall during normal business hours.

**REMODELING/ALTERATIONS:** A building permit is required. Fees are doubled if work is begun prior to obtaining a permit [Ordinance Sec. 15-1-19(e)]. The Building Inspector can be reached through the Village office with any questions or call Independent Inspections at 1-800-422-5220.

# Garbage



The Village of Dane contracts with Waste Management for curbside pick up of trash and recyclables. Trash is picked up every Wednesday, recyclables every other Wednesday (see schedule on the next page). If a holiday falls on a day before Wednesday, trash pick up will be Thursday. **Please note that Waste Management may start as early as 7 am collecting.**

Please remember to separate your recyclables from your garbage failure to do so may result in your trash being left at the curb.

Due to changes in the law, **the village can no longer pick up refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other appliances that use Freon.** Please keep this in mind when buying new appliances. Contact Waste Management at 1-800-960-0008 for pick up of these appliances for a fee.

Please note that if you have additional bags that do not fit in your container please contact Waste Management, prior to collection day and they will pick up the additional bags.

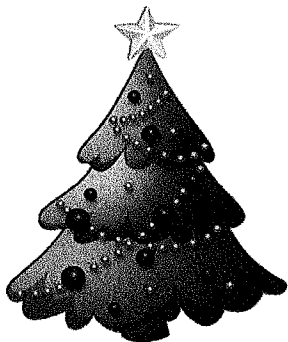
Below is a listing of prices for collection of specific large item:

Carpets and/or pads - \$1.50 per sq. yard  
Mattresses, Furniture & sofas - \$25.00 each  
Small appliances (microwaves, toaster/pizza ovens) - \$35 each  
Big appliances (refrigerators, freezers) - \$ 50.00 each  
Commercial appliances (with Freon) - \$ 75.00 each  
Computers, TV's and other electronics - \$ 17.00 - \$30 each *(starting in January, the new electronic recycling law comes into affect - so the pickup/disposal of these types of items WILL change according to the regulations set forth by the state and the DNR, though penalties will not be issued until September 1st, 2010)*

Please contact Waste Management for the pick up of these items at 1-800-960-0008.

Village staff will pick up brush, metal and appliances that do not contain Freon on the **second Tuesday of each month.** Brush must be tied and bundled with ends facing the same direction in lengths of six feet or less and not weighing more than 50 lbs. A charge for labor costs may be assessed for disposal of large amounts of brush. There will be a charge for items picked up on a day other than the second Tuesday.

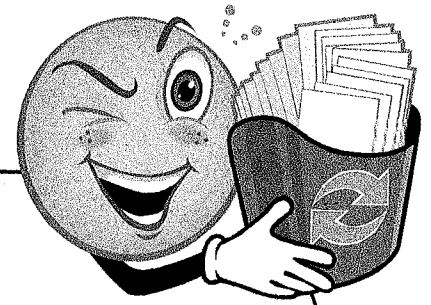
The Dane Dandy Doers 4-H Club has a container for aluminum cans at the Town of Dane garage located at 213 W Main St.

## Village Hall Rental

Reservations cannot be made more than one year in advance (no standing reservations with the exception of non-profit groups). Only residents of the Dane/Vienna fire district can rent the hall. Due to recent problems with damage done to the hall, the board has voted to increase the deposit to \$500. Deposits will be refunded if the hall is left clean and undamaged.

The fees are as follows:

- Wedding - \$150 plus a \$500 deposit.
- All other events: \$75 plus a \$500 deposit.

There is no charge for non-profit groups.
