An Ordinance to Amend

Section 9-2-9

Credit for Water Not Discharged to Sewer

Code of Ordinances, Village of Dane, Wisconsin

The Village Board of the Village of Dane, Dane County, do ordain as follows:

Sec. 9-2-9 Credit for Water Not Discharged to Sewer.

(a) If a portion of the water furnished to any customer is not discharged into the sewer system, the quantity of such water will be deducted in computing the charge for sewer service provided a **temporary** meter has been installed to measure such water.

~~(b) The customer must at his own expense make necessary changes in the water piping and install couplings so that a meter can be set. A charge of seventy five cents (75c) a quarter shall be made for each such meter up to a one (1) inch meter.~~

(b) The credit set forth in paragraph (a) above shall be available to a customer, provided the customer does not use more than 16,000 gallons per month or 48,000 gallons per quarter, as measured by the temporary meter installed for that purpose. Any water not discharged to the sewer system as measured by the customer's temporary meter over the maximum 16,000 gallons per month or 48,000 gallons per quarter shall incur sewer usage charges at the regular established rates.

(c) No permanent meters shall be installed for purposes of receiving credit for water not discharged to sewer.

(d) A temporary meter may be issued to a customer after a deposit of fifty dollars (\$50.00) is submitted to the Village of Dane. Deposits are refunded after the return of the temporary meter. Temporary meters are only to be used when a significant amount of water is to be used in one single occurrence. Temporary meters may not be issued for a period longer than two (2) months.
